

**USBC Sanction No. 08498**

\$20.00 Entry Fee Per Event (See Rule #4 for Breakdown)

1. Entry closing date will be February 6, 2020. **Walk-ins accepted with a \$5.00 late fee if lanes are available. Check-in will close 30 minutes before each squad.**
2. This tournament is open to all bowlers who hold a USBC Youth Membership and are in good standing with their league(s).
3. **Handicap will be 100% of 210.**
4. Tournament Fee Breakdown for each category: Lineage: **\$8.85** - Tournament Expenses: **\$2.65** - Prize Fund: **\$8.50**.
5. **Entering Averages:**
 - a. January 1, 2020 average with 12 or more games – from GMUSBC leagues or bowl.com
 - b. Highest 2018-2019 yearbook average – including summer - from GMUSBC leagues or bowl.com
 - c. Summer 2019 average with 12 games
 - d. High school bowlers with no league averages may use high school average, provided they have purchased a sanction card and have a minimum of 12 games. A card may be purchased at the event for \$4.00.
 - e. If a bowler's home association isn't GMUSBC, the averages used will be the highest shown on bowl.com.
 - f. Bowlers from outside Dade County should bring appropriate average verification; such as a league standing sheet.
 - g. If average cannot be verified or the bowler does not have an average, the bowler will bowl scratch.
6. All team entries will consist of Three (3) members – no vacancies allowed. **Doubles and Singles may be bowled as separate events. Bowlers will be allowed to bowl just singles or doubles.** To win All Events bowlers must enter all three events – Team, Doubles & Singles. **See Rule 13 below for multiple entry information.**
7. If doing Doubles and Singles they will be bowled together on the same pair of lanes – doubles being bowled first.
8. List bowlers in the order in which they will bowl (this line-up will be used on score sheet and cannot be changed).
9. This tournament shall abide by all USBC Tournament rules and regulations. Anyone who fails to abide by these rules and regulations is subject to disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees. Any bowler who conducts himself or herself in any manner deemed not within the standards of youth bowlers shall be suspended by the tournament director. They shall also be disqualified from further participation in the tournament and reported to USBC for formal suspension from USBC. Disqualified contestants will not be reimbursed for any fees paid.
10. Any discrepancies must be brought to the attention of a tournament official. The decision of the tournament committee is final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329. All rules not covered will be governed by USBC rules.
11. Bowlers will be competing for scholarship prizes. All scholarship money will be deposited with SMART. 1st place awards in each division will be given. Awards will be given with a ratio of **1:4** entries for each division. Each division will have its own prize fund.
12. Multiple entries will be permitted. A contestant bowling singles may only win once using his/her highest score. The first singles score bowled shall count toward the “All Event” score. Re-entry in doubles and teams with the same partners will be allowed. The first doubles/team score will count toward the “All Event” score. Bowlers entering more than once may win as many times as the team/doubles finish but may only win once with the exact same team/doubles partners.
13. **No one will be permitted to bowl wearing any apparel or using any equipment with alcohol or tobacco advertising or suggestive, obscene lettering or pictures. No midribs or tank tops will be allowed. Knee length shorts will be allowed.** Bowling shoes must be worn by bowlers – no street shoes allowed. **No hats, headphones, or electronic devices may be worn on the lanes by bowlers. This rule will be strictly enforced.**
14. All bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn to bowl. Food and drinks must be kept outside of the bowling circle. Alcohol is not permitted while bowling in this tournament. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the bowling circle. Only tournament officials may change scores.
